INSTRUCTIONS FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

MODALITIES: 1) Research
2) Clinical case

ORAL

Oral session will have an average of six papers and each author will have a maximum of 15 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for plenary questions. The session will be attended by two members of the Evaluation Committee who will assign grades to the candidate. At the end of the presentations there will be a space for debate with the audience present. At the end of the presentations, the evaluators must select the best work from the oral session.



POSTER

Each poster demonstration must present a short, precise procedure, technique, or research topic that can be discussed in a 2-4 minute period and repeated as many times as necessary during the three hours. Long or complicated presentations are outside the scope of this program. A maximum of three speakers are allowed per presentation and it must be live.

GENERAL RULES

Presentations will be selected for the program on the basis of the scientific quality of the work as judged from the abstract. An impartial panel of reviewers (three persons per Scientific Group/Network) will evaluate the content of each abstract. Selection of the abstracts will be made by these reviewers whose decision is final. Following are the topics that the abstract should contain and that will be evaluated. In the final analysis, it will be the reviewers' judgment of the value of any abstract that will determine whether the abstract should appear on the program. Since the abstracts are published and become part of the world's scientific literature, it is important that the content be scientifically sound and grammatically correct. Each abstract is reviewed so that high standards can be ensured.

NOTIFICATIONS OF ACCEPTANCE/NONACCEPTANCE

The official notifications will be emailed on or about late April, 2024, to all accepted presenters. The notifications will include presentation mode, date, and session time. An email containing the Final Presentation # and the Template will be sent after the Presenter Pre-registration deadline (April 30, 2024), to all registered, accepted presenters.
